Helps 117 students in at-risk neighborhoods with the support needed to deal with hunger, homelessness, poverty, exposure to violence and mental health struggles.

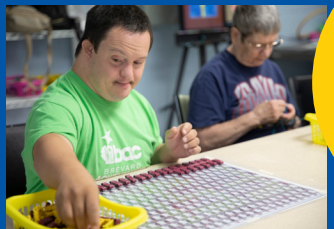
FEED AND READ

Helps a person with a developmental disability with supported living services for a year allowing for greater independence and a better quality of life.

How does United Way determine which programs are vital to supporting our community's needs?

When you give to the Community Care Fund nearly 75 volunteers spend over 1,000 hours to help determine how to meet a broad array of needs supported by both our Safety Net Services and Targeted Care. The allocations process is an annual certification designed to give donors peace of mind that their money is being put to the best possible use in Brevard. Programs that comply with these standards have provided documentation that they meet standards in governance, operations and support to the community.
